- Manage risk by maintaining systems to identify, assess, monitor and control hazards and by reviewing performance. This is documented, maintained, audited and relevant certification is retained,
- Seek continual improvement through a framework of setting and reviewing safety objectives and targets, assessing and reporting on railway operations safety performance,
- Provide a structure and responsibility in order to facilitate effective railway safety management to contribute effectively to the company's business,
- Communicate this policy to employees, contractors and visitors and ensure their understanding obligations in respect of this policy,
- Maintain open communication with all stakeholders on railway related issues where applicable and contribute to the development of sound legislation,
- Provide a collaborative forum where employees and employee representatives can actively participate and contribute to company rules, standards and procedures pertaining to railway operations.



Our responsibility
